ABOUT LUNDÚ

Named after an Afro-Peruvian rhythm, Lundú joined together in 2017 by a love of Perú's song traditions. Like many locally grounded roots groups around the world, they are based outside of their nation's capital city. Arequipa is a musical outlier when compared to Lima, which is 600 miles to the north. Perú's second largest city sits 2,335 meters above sea level in the Andes mountains, surrounded by volcanos, and with a complex syncretic culture that encompasses Afro-Peruvian, Andean, and colonial Spanish histories; its 15th century center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Here, Lundú is crafting a distinctive musical vocabulary, as it interprets and extends a musical legacy with passion and finesse. Lundú's U.S. debut tour features songs from their new album *Afroestampa Vol 1*, produced by Latin Grammy nominee Javier Lazo, and their 2019 debut LP, *Introversiones*. www.lundumusic.com #lundumusic

“We’re an ongoing musical conversation, drawing on the sounds of the Andes and the coast, in dialogue with ancestral and contemporary peoples, to share the stories of our nation today and the collective Latin American spirit.” – Lundú

Lundú made its first international appearance in Panama in 2018, and has participated in “Sonamos Latinoamerica” festival from 2018-2020, toured to Argentina, and shared stages with musicians from Uruguay, Chile, Colombia, and Ecuador. Commissioned by Baltimore's Center for Cultural Vibrancy and Creative Alliance, Lundú produced a 20-minute video about their life and work in Arequipa, available to schools and other groups nationwide via screenings and discussions. The band's U.S. debut tour, February 18-March 17, 2022 features stops in Gainesville, FL; Baltimore, MD; Washington, DC; Yakima, WA; and New York City.

Lundú is one of five ensembles from Colombia and Perú touring the U.S. from February-June 2022 as part of Center Stage, a public diplomacy program that has introduced and toured performing artists from abroad in the United States since 2012. To date, 29 groups from Algeria, Egypt, Haiti, Indonesia, Morocco, Pakistan, Tanzania, Ukraine, and Vietnam have made month-long tours from coast to coast. As hosted by colleges and universities, festivals, music clubs, and cultural centers, Center Stage ensembles reach large cities and small towns. They engage with communities onstage, offstage, and online through performances, workshops, and discussions, artist-to-artist exchanges, master classes, and community gatherings, and return home to share these experiences with peers and fans.

- If unvaccinated (including all children) bring a hardcopy or digital image of a negative PCR COVID result from a test collected no sooner than 72 hours prior to the performance. (home tests and rapid tests not accepted)
